



## CODES OF CONDUCT

### FOR 360 DANCERS:

- RESPECT. Always listen to and respect your teachers and fellow students.
- BE ON TIME. Arrive in good time classes. Arriving late for class means you may miss information and be at risk of injury if you miss the warm up.
- BE POLITE. Good manners must be used at all times and no bad language will be tolerated.
- 360 Dancers will not distract, bully or harass others at any time in class, or when representing the school at external events.
- Treat all equipment with care.
- UNIFORM. 360 uniform must be worn at every class
- HAIR. Hair must be neat and tied back for every class and in a ballet bun for ballet classes.
- JEWELLERY: No jewellery to be worn in class to prevent injury to yourself and others.
- FOOD AND DRINK. No food is allowed in the studio. Water is allowed in named, sealed drinking bottles.
- TIDY UP. Please keep all changing areas tidy and ensure any rubbish is cleared away.
- MOBILE PHONES must be switched off in class.
- INJURY/ILLNESS: Advise your teacher at the beginning of class if you are injured. Inform them immediately in class if you become unwell or injured.
- ENJOY: We are here to work hard, train well and most importantly have fun. Come to class with focus, discipline and a smile!

Continuous breach of the code of conduct will result in the parents being informed to discuss the situation. If there is no improvement, then parents will be invited to discuss the future behaviour of their child and agree joint strategies for monitoring. In extreme cases where physical violence, verbal abuse or intentional damage to property is involved, the sequence of actions outlined above will be by-passed and the Principal will contact the parents as a first step. Exclusion of the child from the school may be considered.

### FOR 360 PARENTS/GUARDIANS

- Ensure you arrive in adequate time for your child to be ready for class and let the teacher know if you are going to be late. Make sure your child has been to the toilet before class begins.
- Collect your child promptly at the end of class.
- Please ensure your child is dressed in 360 Uniform for class and has neat hair, and a bun for ballet classes.
- Parents are not permitted into the studio to watch. You will be invited to watch a class at the end of each term.
- Respect all teachers and the decisions they make. All 360 teachers are qualified and experienced and best placed to understand each students progress.
- Aggressive behaviour towards any teacher, fellow parent or child will not be tolerated and may lead to your child losing their place at 360 Dance.

- Use correct and proper language always.
- Be encouraging! Praise your child and guide them to be responsible for their own performance and behaviour.
- Be realistic about your child's abilities and do not compare with others. Praise their own personal achievements and progress.
- Do not force your child to participate in class.
- Set a good example and support other 360 Dancers to demonstrate good sportsmanship.
- Do not raise disagreements publicly. Speak with your teacher or contact the Principal directly.
- All fees are to be paid on time or a late payment fee will be charged.

Continuous breach of the code of conduct may lead to your child losing their place at 360 Dance.



## 360 DANCE CODE OF CONDUCT

360 Dance is committed to providing exceptional dance training to all students, and encouraging them to reach their full potential whilst fostering a love of dance and theatre. We are inclusive and will promote the wellbeing of all our students regardless of their ethnicity, gender, age, religion, disability.

- All 360 Dancer teachers are fully qualified and have appropriate DBS checks in place and are fully insured.
- We will always prioritise the well-being and safety of our dancers.
- We will teach well planned and structured lessons.
- We will work with respect to our students to develop a positive working environment.
- We will never undermine or belittle our students, or abuse our authority as teachers.
- We are aware of our own limits as teachers and will respect our training and knowledge. We will keep our teaching skills up to date and keep our knowledge of syllabus up to date and secure.
- We will ensure all classes are age appropriate and meet the abilities of each student.
- All our students are individuals and we will treat them as such. We will set them realistic goals to develop their confidence.
- We will use positive praise and encouragement to ensure class is a fun and rewarding experience. We will not punish children for mistakes- mistakes are a natural part of development and learning.
- All 360 teachers and staff will demonstrate high standards of behaviour, appropriate language and be well presented at all times.
- We will not be under the influence of alcohol whilst any children are in are care.
- We will work with the parents and guardians of the school to ensure the best interests of our students.
- We will manage behaviour effectively to ensure a positive and safe learning environment.
- We are a registered RAD and ISTD dance school and we will Have due regard for, and comply

with, all relevant policies, rules and regulations published by the RAD and ISTD. We are proud of all our past examination results.

- We will ensure our policies are in place and up to date to protect and safeguard all children, parents and staff at 360 Dance. These will be adhered to and updated annually to meet any legislation changes.
- We will act with integrity in all professional and business judgements, demonstrating honesty, fair dealing, courtesy and consideration for other dance professionals, organisations, students and their families at all times.
